

RESOLUTION NO. 73721

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE ADOPTING THE ASSOCIATION OF BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS (ABAG) MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL REPORT, ENTITLED "TAMING NATURAL DISASTERS" AS THE CITY'S LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 ("DMA 2000") requires local governments to have a hazard mitigation plan, approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA"), to be eligible to receive Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds for disasters declared after November 1, 2004 and future mitigation project funding; and

WHEREAS, DMA 2000 allows local governments to prepare a single jurisdiction hazard mitigation plan or to participate in the development of a multi-jurisdictional plan and attach strategies as an annex to the multi-jurisdictional plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of San José ("City") has joined with 60 local jurisdictions in the San Francisco Bay Area to participate in the development of a multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan by the Association of Bay Area Governments ("ABAG"), entitled "Taming Natural Disasters," which plan has been preliminarily accepted by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to adopt the ABAG report as its local hazard mitigation plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) multi-jurisdictional report, entitled "Taming Natural Disasters" is hereby approved as the City of San José's local hazard mitigation plan.
