

RESOLUTION NO. 73859

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE THE SIXTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR AIRPORT BUS SERVICE WITH THE SANTA CLARA VALLEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, on March 3, 1998, the San Jose City Council approved an Agreement between the City of San Jose and the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) to provide bus services, the San Jose Airport Flyer, linking the Airport with the Metro Light Rail Station and the Santa Clara Transit Station and CalTrain; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement has been amended five times to continue the bus service; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to negotiate and execute an amendment to the agreement with VTA to continue this bus service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to:

- (a) Negotiate and execute the Sixth Amendment to the Agreement for Airport Bus Service with the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority, extending the term from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2010, with the option for the City to extend the Agreement for up to two (2) additional two-year terms, with first year compensation to the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority in an amount not to exceed \$1,400,000 and with compensation for subsequent years subject to adjustment based upon the Consumer Price Index, and subject to appropriation of funds for each year.
- (b) Exercise up to two (2) two-year options to extend the Agreement, subject to appropriation of funds for each option year.
