

RESOLUTION NO. 73877

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN JOSE CONSERVATION CORPS FOR RECYCLING SERVICES AT SPECIAL EVENTS

WHEREAS, in AB 2176 (Stats. 2004, Chap. 879) the Legislature set forth findings that large venues and large events generate substantial quantities of solid waste, primarily compostable materials and materials such as corrugated cardboard, beverage containers, paper and glass that can be reused or recycled; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to ensure that cost-effective waste reduction and recycling assistance and service is available for operators of special events held in San José; and

WHEREAS, the San José Conservation Corps (“SJCC”) has experience providing recycling services for special events; and

WHEREAS, the SJCC receives funding from the State of California for beverage container recycling programs, and has offered to provide such these services at no or very low cost; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to engage the SJCC to provide recycling services at special events to increase the recycling and waste diversion rates at special events;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE:

The City Manager, or the City Manager’s designee, is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement with the San José Conservation Corps for recycling services at special events at no cost to the special events operators for an initial term of one year with options to extend the term for up to two one-

year extensions. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is hereby authorized to exercise such options to extend.
