

RESOLUTION NO. 73879

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AMENDING THE SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES TO REVISE THE SOURCE REDUCTION AND RECYCLING FEE FOR ELIGIBLE PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72737 setting forth the Schedule of Fees and Charges effective July 1, 2005; and

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2006, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 73342 amending various sections of the Schedule of Fees and Charges effective July 1, 2006;

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2007, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 73831 amending various sections of the Schedule of Fees and Charges effective July 1, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the Schedule of Fees and Charges to revise the Source Reduction and Recycling Fee for eligible school districts;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE:

Section 7.010 of Part 7 of Resolution No. 72737, as amended by Resolution No. 73242, is amended to read as follows:

7.010 Source Reduction and Recycling (AB939) Fee
(SJMC §§ 9.10.1120, 9.10.1435)

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| a. | Recycle Plus Cart Service (See, Service Rates Resolution for Lifeline category descriptions) | |
| 1. | Lifeline (175) | Included in Service Rate |
| 2. | Single Family | Included in Service Rate |
| 3. | Multi-Family | Included in Service Rate |
| b. | Commercial Solid Waste | \$0.89 per uncompacted cubic yard collected (paid by generators)
\$2.67 per compacted cubic yard (paid by generators) |

- c. Waste collected from a public school district providing education in grades K-12 (or any grades within K-12) that has entered into a Waste Reduction Agreement with the City and waste collected from an adult education institution supported by public funds that has entered into a Waste Reduction Agreement with the City Ø per cubic yard

- d. Solid Waste Collected pursuant to the Agreement for Solid Waste Collection at City Facilities, upon the City's election of weight-based service; if the City does not elect weight-based service, the fees for Commercial Solid Waste shall apply \$14.83 per ton collected (or an equivalent fee determined by the Director of Environmental Services in the case of front-loader collection service where scales are not available)
