

RESOLUTION NO. 73886

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE FIXING AND DETERMINING RATES, FARES, AND TARIFFS FOR THE OPERATION OF TAXICABS IN THE CITY OF SAN JOSE OUTSIDE THE AIRPORT PURSUANT TO MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 6.64**

**WHEREAS**, the rates for the operation of taxicabs in the City of San Jose were established by Resolution 71336, pursuant to San Jose Municipal Code Chapter 6.64; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 73885 establishes rates for operation of taxicabs at the Norman Y. Mineta San Jose International Airport ("Airport") and repeals Resolution 71336; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to establish the rates for taxicabs operating in the City of San Jose outside of the Airport;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

**SECTION 1. REGULAR TAXI SERVICE**

The following rates, fares, and tariffs for taxicabs operating in the City of San Jose outside of the Airport are hereby fixed and determined pursuant to San Jose Municipal Code §6.64.250:

**A. FLAG DROP:**

In all areas in the City of San Jose outside of the Airport, the flag drop rate is Two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) for the initial use of the taxicab, including the first one-tenth (1/10) mile of travel.

**B. MILEAGE RATE:**

Beginning after the mileage included in the flag drop, twenty-five cents (\$0.25) per one-tenth (1/10) mile of travel or portion thereof.

**C. WAITING TIME RATE:**

Twenty-five cents (\$0.25) per 36 seconds, for a maximum of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per hour.

“Waiting Time” is that time when:

1. The taxicab is proceeding at speed of thirteen (13) miles per hour or less in traffic, or
2. The taxicab is stopped for a period of time at the request of the passenger.

**D. SURCHARGE:**

Mileage rate after ten (10) miles past the Santa Clara County line, twenty-five percent (25%) surcharge each additional mile or portion thereof.

**SECTION 2.**

For users of taxicab services who are handicapped or are 65 years of age or older, a minimum fifteen percent (15%) discount will be taken from the total regular fare.

Taxicabs providing subsidized fares may provide a discount greater than fifteen percent (15%) off the total regular fare.

**SECTION 3.**

The rates and charges specified herein shall be effective on July 1, 2007.
