

RESOLUTION NO. 73892

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH MIKYOUNG KIM TO FABRICATE AND INSTALL ARTWORK FOR THE SOUTH SAN JOSE POLICE SUBSTATION IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$340,000

WHEREAS, with the passage of the Public Safety Bond Measures in March 2002, the City of San José ("City") is building or upgrading public safety municipal facilities and a two percent (2%) public art budget has been established as part of the budget process; and

WHEREAS, a \$1,000,000 budget for public art for the South San José Police Substation was identified as part of the capital project; and

WHEREAS, an artist selection panel convened to review the submitted material of fourteen artists responding to invitations to apply for the project, and Artists Mikyoung Kim and Thomas Sayre were selected as the project artists and a budget of \$800,000 was divided equally between the artists; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2006 the Arts Commission approved the design contract for Mikyoung Kim in the amount of \$60,000 and on April 11, 2007 the Arts Commission accepted the proposed design and recommended approval of the fabrication and installation agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to negotiate and execute an agreement with Mikyoung Kim to fabricate and install artwork for the South San José Police Substation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement with Mikyoung Kim for the fabrication and installation of a work of art for the South San José Police Substation in an amount not to exceed \$340,000.
