

RESOLUTION NO. 73918

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH FAIR ISAAC CORPORATION FOR WORKERS COMPENSATION COST CONTAINMENT SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$750,000

WHEREAS, in December, 2006, the City of San José (“City”) released a Request for Proposal for workers’ compensation cost containment services, which services include review of medical bills, a contracted preferred provider organization, utilization review of recommended treatment plans, and medical case management; and

WHEREAS, the City’s evaluation team has determined that the proposal of Fair Isaac Corporation is the most advantageous proposal and best meets the needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to negotiate and execute an agreement with Fair Isaac Corporation for an initial one-year term beginning July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008, with up to four one-year options to renew, subject to appropriation of funds by the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to:

1. Negotiate and execute an agreement with Fair Isaac Corporation for workers' compensation cost containment services for the period of July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008, in an amount not to exceed \$750,000.
2. Execute up to four one-year options to renew the agreement, in an amount not to exceed \$750,000 per year, subject to appropriation of funds by the City Council.
3. In the event negotiations for the new agreement are not completed by June 30, 2007, execute a continuation agreement to extend the term of the current agreement for a period of up to three months.
