

RESOLUTION NO. 73939

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THOMAS SAYRE FOR A WORK OF ART FOR THE SOUTH SAN JOSE POLICE SUBSTATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$340,000

WHEREAS, the City of San Jose ("City") is undertaking construction of a new South San José Police Substation ("SSJPS"), and has budgeted funds for public artwork for the SSJPS; and

WHEREAS, artist Thomas Sayre was previously commissioned by the City to develop a design proposal for artwork for the SSJPS and subsequently developed a proposal for a glass wall artwork which will abstractly represent the variations of the landscape/cityscape that comprise the City of San José; and

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2007, the Public Art Committee, acting for the Arts Commission, accepted the proposed design and recommended approval of the fabrication and installation agreement with the artist; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to negotiate and execute an agreement with Thomas Sayre to fabricate and install a work of art for the SSJPS in an amount not to exceed \$340,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement with Thomas Sayre for the fabrication and installation of a work of art for the South San Jose Police Substation in an amount not to exceed \$340,000.
