

RESOLUTION NO. 73940

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ACCEPTANCE
OF AN EASEMENT AGREEMENT FOR RECYCLED WATER
SERVICE CONNECTIONS AND METER VAULTS STATE FROM THE
TRUSTEES OF THE CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY**

WHEREAS, the recycled water line designed to service the New City Hall and the new MLK Library runs from the 12th Street to the Fourth Street along San Fernando Street; and

WHEREAS, upon the request of the San Jose State University, an additional service connection was added near Ninth Street, to service University landscape irrigation; and

WHEREAS, the original recycled water line design included only short service connections stubs within the street ROW, the design was later revised to extend the service connections beyond the street ROW into the University property to construct meter vaults from where the service lines would be extended; and

WHEREAS, easements are needed from the University in order to maintain and service the service connections and the meter vaults that are located on University property outside the public right of way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is authorized to execute and acceptance of the easement agreement fro recycled water service connections and meter vaults with The Trustees of The California State University.
