

RESOLUTION NO. 73964

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSÉ SETTING POPULATION LIMITS FOR PURPOSES OF CALCULATING THE VOLUNTARY EXPENDITURE LIMITS FOR THE 2008 MUNICIPAL ELECTION CYCLE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Jose has established a Voluntary Campaign Expenditure Limits Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has set a formula for Expenditure Limits at Seventy-five (.75) cents per resident of the City for candidates for the office of Mayor and One (\$1) dollar per resident of the district for candidates for Council office; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 12.06.530 of the San Jose Municipal Code requires that the City Council adopt an Expenditure Limits Resolution, in advance of each election cycle, which specifies the expenditure limits based on population data supplied by the Director of the Department of Planning, Building and Code Enforcement.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSÉ THAT:
