

RESOLUTION NO. 73974

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A RIGHT-OF-WAY COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN JOSE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, SANTA CLARA COUNTY, AND VALLEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR FINAL TRANSFER OF PROPERTY INTERESTS PERTAINING TO THE GUADALUPE CORRIDOR PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Guadalupe Corridor Project constructed freeway, light rail transit (LRT) and bicycle facilities along the current Route 87 corridor from Route 280 to Route 85 and freeway and LRT facilities along Route 85 from Route 87 to Miyuki Avenue in the City of San Jose; and

WHEREAS, as a result of an expedited schedule to complete the Guadalupe Corridor project and Route 85, final right-of-way engineering activities for the Corridor were deferred until completion of the Route 85 project in 1994; and

WHEREAS, in 2005, a team of representatives from the City of San Jose (Transportation and Public Works), County of Santa Clara, Caltrans and VTA formed to complete the various transfers contemplated in the original Joint Powers Board Agreement for the Guadalupe Corridor Project, which expired in 1989; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to negotiate and execute a Right-of-Way Cooperative Agreement between the City of San Jose the State of California (Department of Transportation or "Caltrans"), the County of Santa Clara, and the Valley Transportation Authority (the "Agreement") in conjunction with the Guadalupe Corridor Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the Agreement for the Guadalupe Corridor Project.
