

RESOLUTION NO. 73999

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A COMPREHENSIVE APPROACHES TO SEX OFFENDER MANAGEMENT (CASOM) GRANT FROM THE BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000, AND TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the Comprehensive Approaches to Sex Offender Management (“CASOM”) Program under the United States Department of Justice assists state, local and tribal jurisdictions in improving their adult and juvenile sex offender management policies and practices; and

**WHEREAS**, in December, 2006, the San José Police Department applied to the Bureau of Justice Assistance, which administers the CASOM grants, for grant funds to initiate its Compliance Check Program to review and update data on 2,281 sex registrants, provide training to patrol officers, conduct compliance checks on registrants, and share results of program efforts to enhance collaborations with other agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of San José (“City”) has been notified by the Bureau of Justice Assistance that the grant has been awarded, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to accept the CASOM grant award for the specified purpose;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The City Manager is authorized to accept the Comprehensive Approaches to Sex Offender Management grant from the Bureau of Justice Assistance in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.

2. The City Manager is further authorized to execute any necessary documents to effectuate the grant.
