

RESOLUTION NO. 74071

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AMENDING THE EXEMPTION APPROVED FOR THE SAN PEDRO STREET TRAFFIC CALMING PILOT PROJECT AT THE JUNE 5, 2007 CITY COUNCIL MEETING, TO PROVIDE FOR TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES OTHER THAN ROAD LUMPS

WHEREAS, the current Traffic Calming Policy 5-6 was approved by the San José City Council (“City Council”) in June 2001, outlining the different types of traffic calming services and providing a process for neighborhoods experiencing adverse traffic conditions to petition the City of San José (“City”) for the installation of comprehensive traffic calming solutions and for traffic calming measures to be incorporated into development projects that may result in adverse traffic conditions in existing neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2007, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 73808 which exempted the San Pedro Street Traffic Calming Pilot Project from Traffic Calming Policy 5-6 and from the petition process contained within the policy with regard to traffic calming measures along San Pedro Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Department of Transportation together with the Fire Department and the Traffic Committee of the Vendome Neighborhood Association (“VNA”) reviewed sample road lumps of similar size and configuration of the intended road lumps for San Pedro Street; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Committee of the VNA wishes to explore alternative physical devices for San Pedro Street in lieu of road lumps;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The exemption to the San Pedro Street Traffic Calming Pilot Project adopted at the June 5, 2007 City Council meeting is hereby amended to provide for traffic calming measures other than road lumps along San Pedro Street.
