

RESOLUTION NO. 74130

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE ACCEPTING A DONATION OF \$17,500 FROM THE ROTARY CLUB OF SAN JOSE TO BE USED FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF ADAPTIVE SWINGS IN CITY PARKS TO FACILITATE EQUAL PLAY FOR SPECIAL NEEDS CHILDREN

WHEREAS, in July 2007, the Rotary Club of San José (“Rotary Club”) presented a proposal to donate \$17,500 to fund the purchase and installation of special adaptive swings in the City of San José (“City”) parks to enrich the quality of play for all children in San José; and

WHEREAS, the Rotary Club’s donation will enable the City to fund the installation of special adaptive swings in certain parks throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to accept the donation of \$17,500 from the Rotary Club for the specified purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City hereby accepts the donation of \$17,500 from the Rotary Club of San José to be used for the purchase and installation of adaptive swings in City parks to facilitate equal play for special needs children.
