

RESOLUTION NO. 74173

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE APPROVING THE LANGUAGE ACCESS PLAN TO IMPROVE ACCESS TO HOUSING SERVICES FOR LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENT PERSON IN THE CITY OF SAN JOSE

WHEREAS, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 requires that organizations receiving federal funds ensure equal access to federally funded programs and Executive Order 13166 dated August 11, 2000 directs federal agencies to implement plans that will ensure that clients of organizations receiving federal funds create plans that provide equal access to persons of limited English proficiency;

WHEREAS, the City of San Jose executed a Voluntary Compliance Agreement with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on July 2007 stating that the City would prepare a Language Access Plan (Plan) and send the Plan to HUD by December 30, 2007; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Housing recommends that the City Council adopt the Plan attached to the Director's report dated November 26, 2007 to comply with the federal directives.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT: the Language Access Plan attached to the Director of Housing report dated November 26, 2007 is approved.
