

RESOLUTION NO. 74411

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AN INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000, TO EXECUTE RELATED DOCUMENTS, AND TO ACCEPT ADDITIONAL GRANT AWARDS

WHEREAS, due to increased access to computers and other technology-related communication devices, the potential for online victimization of children and youth, including unwanted exposure to sexual material, unwanted sexual solicitations, and online harassment, has increased; and

WHEREAS, the City of San José ("City") Police Department's Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force, known as the Silicon Valley Internet Crimes Against Children ("SVICAC") Task Force, conducts proactive and reactive investigations into computer and technology crimes perpetrated against children; and

WHEREAS, the SVICAC Task Force received its first federal grant award in 2003, followed by its initial State of California Office of Emergency Services grant award in 2007; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to accept a grant award in the amount of \$250,000 from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services to be used to conduct training, and to purchase laptops and projectors, three vehicles, forensic computers and software, and officer safety gear; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to accept additional grant awards from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services during the next five years, if awarded;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is authorized to:

1. Accept an Internet Crimes Against Children Grant from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.
2. Execute the grant agreement and any other documents necessary to effectuate the grant.
3. Accept any additional Internet Crimes Against Children Grant Awards from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services, and execute any additional grant agreements, as well as other documents necessary to effectuate the additional grants, during the next five years, if awarded.
