

**RESOLUTION NO. 74643**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSÉ AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING FOR THE INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK FORCE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$550,141, AND TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, in February, 2003, the City of San José (“City”) was initially awarded a grant from the United States Department of Justice Office of Criminal Justice Planning for the development of the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (“ICAC Task Force”), which task force combats the activities of child predators and the exploitation of children; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant was continued in 2004 and further continued in 2006 with an additional grant award for the ICAC Task Force’s Child Exploitation Detail (“CED”) to maintain the standardized Response Protocol and Regional Resource Center to investigate computer-facilitated child sexual exploitation by offenders using the Internet, to conduct the annual Silicon Valley Internet Crimes Against Children conference, to allow personnel to attend specialized training, and to purchase other technologies; and

**WHEREAS**, the total grant amount including the second continuation grant is \$1,099,491, and the grant term was extended to September 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has been awarded a third continuation grant in the amount of \$550,141 by the Office of Criminal Justice Planning, to be used in maintaining ICAC Task Force’s CED by funding investigative overtime and training/ travel for sworn personnel, the purchase of three undercover vehicles including maintenance and operating costs, all costs associated with sponsoring the Silicon Valley Internet Crimes Against Children conference to be held in May, 2009, and the purchase of other technologies; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to accept this grant award, to be used for the specified purpose;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSÉ THAT:

The City Manager is authorized to accept the continuation grant from the United States Department of Justice Office of Criminal Justice Planning for Internet Crimes Against Children, in an amount not to exceed \$550,141, on behalf of the City, and to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the grant.
