

**RESOLUTION NO. 74667**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR A CALIFORNIA GANG REDUCTION, INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$400,000, TO ACCEPT THE GRANT IF AWARDED, AND TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS AND AMENDMENTS TO THE GRANT AGREEMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San José (“City”) has been notified that the Governor’s Office of Emergency Services is offering \$6.3 million in California Gang Reduction, Intervention and Prevention Grants (CalGRIP) to cities for gang prevention, intervention, re-entry, education, job training and skills development, family and community services, and suppression activities; and

**WHEREAS**, Bay Area cities may request a grant award of up to \$400,000, which would cover up to two years of anti-gang programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to apply for grant funding, which would be administered through the San José Bringing Everyone’s Strengths Together (B.E.S.T.) program, and will be used to enhance services which may include but are not limited to gang mediation and intervention services, services to adjudicated youth, parent/family support, capacity building, and community gang awareness trainings; and

**WHEREAS**, if the grant is awarded, the City will be required to provide a match equaling the grant award through local or federal dollars in the form of cash or in-kind services;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The City Manager is authorized to execute and submit an application to the State of California Office of Emergency Services for a California Gang Reduction, Intervention and Prevention Grant in an amount not to exceed \$400,000 to support the efforts of the Mayor’s Gang Prevention Task Force.
2. The City Manager is further authorized to accept the grant on behalf of the City and to negotiate and execute any necessary documents to effectuate the grant.

3. The City Manager is further authorized to negotiate and execute amendments to the grant agreement to extend or modify the grant period, or to accept additional grant funds under this grant in an aggregate amount up to twice the original grant amount.
