

RESOLUTION NO. 74843

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSÉ INCREASING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTINGENCY FOR THE SOUTH SAN JOSE POLICE SUBSTATION PROJECT BY \$3,600,000, TO A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,310,000

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2007, the City Council of the City of San José (“City”) awarded a construction contract in the amount of \$59,997,000 to S.J. Amoroso Construction Company, Inc. to construct the South San José Police Substation Project (“Project”), and approved a construction contingency of \$2,710,000; and

WHEREAS, City staff has determined that the construction contingency of \$2,710,000 will be insufficient to address the outstanding and potential change orders necessary to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to increase the construction contingency by \$3,600,000, to an amount not to exceed \$6,310,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The construction contingency for the South San José Police Substation construction contract with S.J. Amoroso Construction Co., Inc. is increased by \$3,600,000, to a total amount not to exceed \$6,310,000.
