

RESOLUTION NO. 74884

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO JOIN WITH THE COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA AND ELEVEN CITIES IN THE COUNTY TO APPLY TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR A 2009 RECOVERY ACT EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,353,687, TO ACCEPT THE GRANT IF AWARDED, AND TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, as an element of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Justice provides funding for grants to assist law enforcement agencies in an effort to create and preserve jobs and to increase their community policing capacity and crime prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS, the City of San José ("City"), the County of Santa Clara, and eleven other local jurisdictions have been invited to file a joint application for the U.S. Department of Justice 2009 Recovery Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$2,565,061, of which the City's portion is an amount not to exceed \$1,353,687; and

WHEREAS, grant funding is restricted to law enforcement programs, prevention and education programs, and planning, evaluation, and technology improvement programs related to front line law enforcement and should supplement, not supplant, current front-line law enforcement services; and

WHEREAS, the spending plan for the grant funds is to utilize the funds to begin Phase I of the Police Department's Automated Field Reporting/Records Management System, to provide a project manager, phasing in of laptops for the marked fleet, and the Records Management System application interface;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The City Manager is authorized to join with the County of Santa Clara and eleven cities in the County to apply to the U.S. Department of Justice for a 2009 Recovery Act Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant to partially fund the Police Department's Automated Field Reporting/Records Management System.
2. The City Manager is further authorized to accept the grant, if awarded, on behalf of the City.
3. The City Manager is further authorized to negotiate and execute any necessary documents to effectuate the grant, including an agreement with the County of Santa Clara and eleven participating jurisdictions, including the City of Campbell, the City of Cupertino, the City of Gilroy, the Town of Los Gatos, the City of Milpitas, the City of Morgan Hill, the City of Mountain View, the City of Palo Alto, the City of Santa Clara, the City of Sunnyvale, and the City of Saratoga, in an amount not to exceed \$1,353,687 for the City of San José, and any amendments to the agreement.
4. The spending plan for the grant is hereby approved.
