

**RESOLUTION NO. 75104**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR A PATHWAYS OUT OF POVERTY GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,500,000**

**WHEREAS**, on June 24, 2009, the United States Department of Labor Employment and Training Administration announced a solicitation for grant applications to provide disadvantaged participants with “Pathways Out of Poverty” and into employment, with funds made available from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, Green Careers Initiative (“GCI”) is a consortium led by work2future, other local workforce investment boards, roofers, plumbers, carpenters and electrical labor groups, community-based organizations, community colleges, green business services providers, and employers, to create career pathways programs in the green collar sector for low-income populations; and

**WHEREAS**, GCI desires to apply for grant funding to target the energy efficiency, construction, and building retrofit industry sectors, to be used to develop curricula, training courses, workshops, job placement activities, support services, and possible internship and nationally recognized pre-apprenticeship program components for populations living near or below the federal poverty level; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of San José (“City”), on behalf of GCI, desires to apply to the U.S. Department of Labor for a Pathways Out of Poverty grant in an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:**

The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to execute and submit an application on behalf of the Green Careers Initiative consortium to the U.S. Department of Labor for a Pathways Out of Poverty grant in an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000.
