

RESOLUTION NO. 75580

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AN ON-THE-JOB TRAINING NATIONAL EMERGENCY PROGRAM GRANT AWARD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$725,462

WHEREAS, in April, 2010, the United States Department of Labor ("DOL") announced the one-time availability of up to \$90 million in funding for On-the-Job ("OJT") Training National Emergency Grants ("NEG"), through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009; and

WHEREAS, in July, 2010, work2future received notification from the State of California that the State OJT NEG application had been approved, and that work2future's share was \$725,462; and

WHEREAS, work2future will be able to draw down up to 10% of the \$725,362 for initial implementation of the program until the State's final implementation plan is approved by the DOL; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used to provide on-the-job training for the period of June 30, 2010 through June 30, 2012 for dislocated workers experiencing prolonged unemployment from layoffs occurring since the onset of the recession, which funds will enable employers to create training and job opportunities for individuals and allow participants to develop occupational skills while earning a paycheck;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is authorized to accept a National Emergency Program Grant for On-The-Job Training in an amount not to exceed \$725,462.


