

RESOLUTION NO. 75522

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE NEW UNITED MOTORS MANUFACTURING INCORPORATED (NUMMI) RE-EMPLOYMENT GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,274,772

WHEREAS, the New United Motors Manufacturing Incorporated (“NUMMI”) automobile manufacturing plant ceased operations in April 2010, displacing over 4,700 workers, and affecting over 30,000 secondary (supplier) employees, many of whom reside in the work2future’s service area of the City of San José; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Labor through the California Employment Development Department has made available to the City’s work2future program a grant in the amount of \$6, 274,772.00 for dislocated workers from NUMMI to be allocated over fiscal years 2010-2011 and 2011-2012; and

WHEREAS, for fiscal year 2010-2011 work2future was awarded a 25% Additional Assistance Grant in the amount of \$970,000 to provide bridge funding and a National Emergency Grant (“NEG”) Dislocated Workers – NUMMI Project award representing the first incremental allocation in the amount of \$2,006,901; and

WHEREAS, the remaining grant funds of approximately \$3,000,000 are anticipated to be released in fiscal year 2011-2012 to a consortium of local Workforce Investment Boards (“WIBs”), including the City’s work2future, affected by the NUMMI plant closure once certain conditions of the grant funding are met, including but not limited to, outreach and enrollment of potential participants; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will provide for outreach, recruitment, testing and assessments, skills analysis, labor market information workshops, basic and remedial education, Individual Employment Plans, career and peer counseling, occupational and/or vocational skills training, supportive services, job placement, and post job placement follow-up activities for displaced NUMMI workers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the New United Motors Manufacturing Incorporated (NUMMI) Re-Employment Grant award in the amount of \$6,274,772.


