**SUBJECT: PROPOSED LANGUAGE FOR ETHICS AND CONDUCT SECTION
5.3 (C) TO BE DISCUSSED ON SEPTEMBER 17, 2008**

The following language is submitted for the Committee's consideration following its discussion on Wednesday, September 10, 2008:

Any lobbyist registered with the City of San Jose who (1) works for a campaign, whether paid or unpaid, or (2) participates in Lobbyist Fundraising Activity¹ during which contributions of \$1,000 or more are solicited, delivered or made for a campaign in one calendar year, is prohibited from lobbying² for compensation any elected official of the City of San Jose for whom the individual worked, volunteered or participated in Lobbyist Fundraising Activity for the first two years of the term of office for which the official was elected.
