
ANALYSIS

Item 2.23 on the City Council Agenda for June 29, 2004 is a proposed agreement with Police Activities League (PAL) for the operation and scheduling of youth sports at the facility often referred to as the "PAL Stadium Complex", located at 680 S. 34th Street, San Jose, CA.

PAL is a nonprofit, tax-exempt corporation. One of PAL's primary purposes is to support the functions of the City, by providing community youth programs which are often supervised by San Jose police officers, and by improving community relations between the San Jose Police Department and San Jose youth. Any Councilmember who is an uncompensated boardmember of the PAL would be deemed not to have an interest in the proposed contract between the City and PAL, pursuant to California Government Code Section 1091.5(a)(8). Therefore, a Councilmember who is an uncompensated boardmember of the PAL may participate in City's Council's review of this item and may vote on Item 2.23. This memorandum is intended to note this fact in the City's official records pursuant to the requirements of California Government Code Section 1091.5(a)(8).
