

RESOLUTION NO. 403

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NORMAN Y. MINETA SAN JOSE
INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT COMMISSION
RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY COUNCIL ADOPT A
CIVIL ACTION ORDINANCE RELATED TO THE
INTENTIONAL DISRUPTION OF THE AIRPORT
SECURITY SYSTEM FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECOVERY
OF THE CITY'S COSTS IN RESPONDING TO SUCH
INCIDENTS**

WHEREAS, since the events of September 11, 2001, the Norman Y. Mineta San Jose International Airport ("Airport") has been subject to heightened security concerns and restrictions; and

WHEREAS, responding to intentional disruptions to the Airport Security System causes the City of San Jose ("City") to incur increased staff time and resource costs; and

WHEREAS, the Airport has been subject to intentional disruptions to the Airport Security System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Norman Y. Mineta San Jose International Airport Commission recommends that the San Jose City Council adopt a Civil Action Ordinance related to the intentional disruption of the Airport Security System for the purpose of recovering the City's costs in responding to such incidents.
