## **SAMPLE BALLOT PAGES CAN BE TORN OUT FOR EASY REFERENCE WHEN VOTING**

### ***Voters Who Register by Tuesday Can Still Receive a Sample Ballot***

Santa Clara County voters will still receive a Sample Ballot and Voter Information Pamphlet if they register or re-register to vote by Tuesday, October 10<sup>th</sup>. The pamphlet contains instructions for voting, information about local candidates and measures, the voter's assigned polling place location and an application for absentee voting.

The sample ballot pages are located in the center of the pamphlets. They are intended to be torn out so voters can mark their choices easily and use the pages as a quick reference when completing their official ballots.

Once removed from the rest of the pamphlet, the sample ballot pages are the exact images of the optical scan ballots used for absentee voting. The sample ballots list candidates and measures in the same voting order as the touch screens when reading each column from top to bottom.

### **Language Preference**

Santa Clara County provides Sample Ballots in English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Chinese and Tagalog. Voters can update their language preference by calling toll-free (866) 430-VOTE [8683] or completing a Preferred Language Survey card at the polls on Election Day. Survey cards are also available online at [www.sccvote.org](http://www.sccvote.org).

Voters who update their language preference by Tuesday, October 10<sup>th</sup> will receive a Sample Ballot in their new preferred language for the November 7<sup>th</sup> Election.

### **Register to Vote**

Voters who register to vote after October 10<sup>th</sup> will not be sent a Sample Ballot, but they will receive a letter with their assigned polling place location. The last day to register to vote in the November election is October 23<sup>rd</sup>.

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Voters need to re-register only if they have changed their name or address, or would like to change their political party affiliation.
