MUNICIPAL ELECTION 2010
IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER
FOR CANDIDATES**

December 10, 2009	San José's Campaign Contribution Period begins. First day of fundraising. (SJMC 12.06.290)
February 1, 2010	Semi-Annual Campaign Disclosure Statement (Form 460) due for the period July 1 (or from the day committee is formed) - December 31, 2009. Personal delivery or guaranteed overnight delivery service.
February 16, 2010	Opening Day of Nomination Period. Candidates may take out official nomination papers and begin circulating petitions.
February 17, 2010	First day to display campaign signs (SJMC 23.04.760).
March 10, 2010	6:00 p.m. Candidate/Treasurer Workshop co-sponsored by the Fair Political Practices Commission and the City Clerk West Valley Library - 1243 San Tomas Aquino Road
March 12, 2010	Close of Nomination Period. Deadline: 12 Noon.
March 15, 2010	Candidate's Statements - last day to withdraw. (March 18 th in a District <i>if</i> the Nomination Period is extended). The Statement cannot be changed but may be withdrawn up until 5:00 P.M.
March 17, 2010	Last day for extended nominations in a given District <i>if</i> incumbent does not file. Deadline: 12 Noon.
March 18, 2010	Randomized alpha drawing conducted by Secretary of State to determine order of candidates' names on the ballot. Also, last day to withdraw Candidate Statement in any district where the incumbent did not file.
March 22, 2010	1st pre-election Campaign Disclosure Statement (Form 460) due for the period January 1– March 17. File by personal delivery or guaranteed overnight delivery service.
March 24, 2010	5:30 p.m. Candidate Orientation (sponsored by the City Manager's Office in coordination with the City Clerk, City Attorney, other Council Appointees and City Department Heads) Office of the City Manager, City Hall Towers, 17 th Floor

May 22, 2010	Cutoff for San José candidate contributions <i>except</i> personal funds. Money must be in the bank by Saturday at midnight. (SJMC 12.06.290)
May 22-31, 2010	Candidates may continue to contribute personal funds to their campaigns. (SJMC 12.06.295)
May 24, 2010	Last day to register to vote for the June 8, 2010 election
May 27, 2010	2nd Pre-Election Campaign Disclosure Statement (Form 460) due for the period March 18 – May 22. File by personal delivery or guaranteed overnight delivery service
June 1–7, 2010	Total Blackout. No funds <i>from any source</i> can be contributed to any candidate campaign.
June 6, 2010	City Clerk to publish Report on Contributions and Expenditures in San José Mercury News
June 8, 2010	Election Day. Polls open 7 A.M. - 8 P.M.

----Prepare for November 2, 2010 Run-off Election----

June 9, 2010	Begin Campaign Contribution Period for November 2, 2010 runoffs. Fundraising may continue <u>only</u> by <i>run-off candidates</i> .
June 18, 2010	Last day to remove campaign signs, unless candidate is in the November Run-off Election.
June 29, 2010	Tentative date for City Council to adopt resolution declaring the results of the June 8, 2010 Election.
July 27, 2010	Deadline for runoff candidates to change Ballot Designation, in writing, if desired. EC 13107 (e).
August 2nd, 2010	Candidate Semi-Annual Campaign Disclosure Statement (Form 460)s due for the period May 23, 2010 - June 30, 2010. Personal Delivery or first class mail.
August 6, 2010	Deadline for run-off candidates to file a new Candidate Statement of Qualifications for the sample ballot (EC 13307.2) Deadline: 12 Noon
August 12, 2010	Randomized alpha drawing conducted by Secretary of State to determine order of candidates' names on the ballot.

October 5, 2010	1st pre-election Campaign Disclosure Statement (Form 460) due for the period July 1 - September 30. Personal Delivery or guaranteed overnight delivery service.
October 16, 2010	Cutoff for San José candidates to receive contributions <i>except from</i> personal funds. Money must be in the bank by Saturday at midnight (SJMC 12.06.290)
October 17-25, 2010	Candidates may continue to contribute personal funds to their campaigns. (SJMC 12.06.295)
October 18, 2010	Last day to register to vote in the November 4, 2010 election.
October 21, 2010	2nd pre-election Campaign Disclosure Statement (Form 460)s due for the period October 1 - October 16. Personal Delivery or guaranteed overnight delivery service
Oct. 26 - Nov. 2, 2010	Total Blackout. No funds <i>from any source</i> to campaigns.
October 31, 2010	City Clerk to publish Report on Contributions and Expenditures in San José Mercury News.
November 2, 2010	Election Day. Polls open 7 A.M. - 8 P.M.
November 12, 2010	Last day to remove campaign signs.
December 14, 2010	tentative dates for Council to adopt resolution declaring the results of the Run-off Election.
December 8, 2010	Deadline for those elected or defeated in June 2010 to retire debt, including loans (within six months after the date of the election). (SJMC 12.06.710).
January 1, 2011	Newly-elected or re-elected Officeholders assume office for a term ending December 31, 2014.
January 31, 2011	Semi-Annual Campaign Disclosure Statement (Form 460) due for the period October 17 - December 31. Personal Delivery or guaranteed overnight delivery service.
May 2, 2011	Deadline for those elected or defeated in November 2010 to retire debt, including loans (within six months after the date of the election). (SJMC 12.06.710).
July 31, 2011	Semi-Annual Campaign Disclosure Statement (Form 460) due for the period January 1 - June 30 for any candidate who has not terminated committee status.
