## **FINAL REGISTRATION NUMBERS RELEASED FOR JUNE 7<sup>th</sup> SPECIAL ELECTION**

*May 31<sup>st</sup> is the last day to request an absentee ballot by mail*

A total of 75,502 voters are registered for the June 7<sup>th</sup> Special Election; of these, there are 46,433 in the Palo Alto Unified School District and **29,069 in San Jose City Council District 7.**

Polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day. Voters can find their assigned polling place location on the cover of their Sample Ballots or online at [www.smartvoter.org](http://www.smartvoter.org). Polling places can change from one election to the next, so voters are encouraged to look up their assigned location before going to vote.

Voters should also review their Sample Ballots carefully and circle their choices before Election Day, then bring it with them to the polls. Additional information about the Special Election is available online at [www.sccvote.org](http://www.sccvote.org).

### **Absentee Voting**

Tuesday, May 31<sup>st</sup> is the last day to request an absentee ballot by mail for the June 7<sup>th</sup> Election. After the deadline, voters can pick up an absentee ballot in person at the Registrar's Office, 1555 Berger Drive, Building 2, San Jose.

All ballots must be received by the Registrar's Office no later than 8 p.m. on Election Day. They can be returned by mail, in person at the Registrar's Office, or at any Santa Clara County polling place on Election Day.

### **Early Voting**

Voters can cast their ballots early at the Registrar of Voters' Office, Monday – Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. through Election Day. The Registrar's Office will also be open for voting on Election Day from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
