During this meeting, it is the City's intent to establish the framework that will be used during the mediation regarding all retirement issues, including the related ballot measure. Of course, by participating in this session, like your coalition, the City also does not agree to waive its previously expressed view that among other things, its *Seal Beach* obligations have been exhausted.
