




# City of San Jose Major Race/Ethnic Groups as a Percent of Population, 2000-2010\*

Scale: 1 inch = 2.5 miles





# Council District-Level Race/Ethnicity Findings

- Existing Hispanic majority maintained in Districts 3 and 5 (52.7% and 61.8%, respectively), and high Hispanic concentration remained in District 7 (48.5%)
- Existing Asian majority maintained in District 4 (NH\* Asian= 61.0%), and new Asian majority created in District 8 (NH\* Asian= 53.2%)
- Existing White majority maintained in District 9 (NH\* White= 59.2%), but White majority no longer present in Districts 6 and 10 (47.7% and 46.4%, respectively)





## City of San Jose Average Household Size, 2000-2010\*





## City of San Jose Household Size by Council District, 2000-2010\*




