Chair De La Rosa provided a brief overview of the role of the Commission and the timeframe in which they have to complete their work.

Senior Planner Michael Bills gave a brief overview of the redistricting process that the Commission has followed and explained the transfer areas and what they are. He informed the Commission that the population transfer area maps were updated from the meeting of May 18, 2011. He reviewed the methodology that staff used to gather information for the Rubino transfer area.

Commission discussion and exercise followed.

Motion: Commissioner Chirco moved to place transfer areas 6-9e on Plan A and remove 6-9da from the master index. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion for discussion.

Action: Motion carried. (Ayes: 6 and Noes: 5) (Shumb, Mace, Flaughter, Schoennauer, Shelton)

Motion: Commissioner Schumb moved to add 9-6b back on the transfer map.

Action: Motion failed for lack of second.

Commission exercise continued.

Motion: Commissioner De Rollo moved to add an alternative solution called Plan B as an alternative to 6-9e. Commissioner Mace seconded the motion.

Motion: Commissioner Shelton moved a friendly amendment to adopt Plan A with a deletion of 6-9e and adding an alternative area Hillsdale to Capitol, Highway 87 to Canoas Creek calling it Plan B. Commissioner De Rollo accepted the friendly amendment.

Action: Motion carried. (9-1-1) (Abstained: De la Rosa, Opposed Chirco)

Commission continued with another exercise.

Motion: Commissioner Fadness moved to create a Plan C transfer area. Commissioner Schumb seconded the motion.

Action: Motion failed. (Ayes: 4 and Noes: 7) (De Rollo, Flaughner, Schoennauer, Mace, Chirco, De la Rosa, Shelton)
