It is my understanding that the city of San Jose is going through a redistricting process for its council boundaries and I wanted to provide input.

\* the entire Cambrian School District is located in District 9 except for portions of the area near Bagby Elementary School. Moving the boundary of district 9 to include Dry Creek Road to the north would accomplish encompassing the entire Cambrian School District into one council district which is a minor change to the boundaries.

\* this would allow for our school district to work with just one city council office on issues such as crossing guards, homework center funding (in good years), joint-use of facilities, and coordination and support for school, city, and community events.

Our past experience with former Vice Mayor Judy Chirco was an effective partnership and I can only see the adjustment as a benefit to the area, school district, its students, and parents. I can see no disadvantage given the area in question already identifies itself as Cambrian due to its location in our Cambrian School District.
