Redistricting Committee-

My wife attended the May 9<sup>th</sup> meeting and reported to me that there were many concerns from District 6 residents about moving the Dry Creek neighborhood (6-9a and 6-9aa) to district 9 and the committee appeared not to listen to the residents. Thus earlier I wrote an email of concern and attended the May 16<sup>th</sup> meeting myself.

This time the committee seemed to be more open to different options and possibly be listening to the residents, with one suggestion being moving part of the Rubino Circle (area 6-9da) residents to District 9 and leaving areas the Dry Creek neighborhood as part of Willow Glen. I applaud this willingness to listen to the residents in considering this redistricting and support this approach.

I moved back to California in 2005 and selected the Willow Glenn neighborhood as a quality area of San Jose. I personally strongly object to moving my neighborhood to District 9. In fact, although there were multiple proposals discussed I did not hear even one resident of this neighborhood agree with the idea of moving our neighborhood to District 9. Please continue to keep the recommendations consistent with the greater majority of residents of this area.
